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

Dear Parents and Caregivers

Welcome back to 2015! I hope you have had a great break and an enjoyable summer so far. To our new families a huge welcome to you, I know you will make new friends very quickly and enjoy being part of your new second home.

This year we have two new teachers beginning with us. Jazmin Reid will work in the senior area and is in room 9 and our other new teacher Sherree Clarke will be working in room 2 as part of the Jiddles team. I know they are both really excited about being part of the Pongakawa team and we look forward to their contribution over the coming year. David James is enjoying a year's leave and is currently teaching in England where the weather is cold and life very different to the relaxed Pongakawa style.

All staff have been back at school for some time now with teachers, support and administration staff preparing for the school year. As teaching staff we have spent time exploring the possibilities the new lake, wetland and bush offer us as it is an area most schools would need to travel to enjoy. Having it on our doorstep gives us another opportunity to integrate real life learning into our student's day.

In week 5 of this term we will be visited by the Education Review Office. This is the first time the team have been at Pongakawa for five years as we have been part of a programme offered only to those schools the office feels are performing at a sustained high level. I will provide further information in the newsletter over the coming weeks including opportunities you will have to chat to the review officers.

You will no doubt have seen in the media over the past few weeks about the growing cost of education and from a parents point of view I have found this to be true. Many schools now have an expectation that parents will provide a computer or IPad etc for their child as they get older and this can place a huge financial burden on many parents. I am happy to say we have been able to alleviate this struggle completely at Pongakawa and all year 7 and 8 students will be presented with an HP Chrome book in the next few weeks for use during the school day. It will be theirs alone to use and offers a number of exciting new learning possibilities for the future. Parents will be given the option to purchase the chrome book through a one off or time payment method if they would like to take the chrome book home for use after school hours. On leaving Pongakawa for High School the chrome book will be that child's to take with them. There is no expectation on the school's part that parents should do this, rather it is offered as an option should families wish to pick it up. The school will of course provide the chrome book at the same price we paid for it which I believe is important.

Special congratulations to our Office Manager Tracey who married on Saturday and has so loyally come to school today to complete first day tasks. While she will still answer to Mrs Tracey Bristow she is now Mrs Tracey Reid.

Lastly just a reminder or two. Your child should bring their togs every day as they will swim rain or shine in our heated pool. The very sad drowning statistics over the summer show us all how important it is for our children to be confident around water and daily focussed lessons enable this to happen. Also if your child is travelling by bus please chat to them at home about the need to behave in a safe and quiet manner while travelling and should they not be using the service on a particular day please do let the office know ahead of time.
